

BLOCK THREAT MANAGEMENT SOLUTION

The number of mobile phone confiscations increased from 9,600 in 2014 to over 15,000 last year - a 56% rise. In England and Wales, there was an average of 9 discoveries per 100 prisoners in 2011, to at least 18 per 100 prisoners in 2017 (the equivalent of 1 in 6). Access to mobile phones has often been associated with the spread of synthetic drugs because prisoners are able to contact outside links to arrange to get illicit items into the prison.

With Unify BLOCK, threats to prison security and the local community can be managed effectively by intercepting the unauthorised use of mobile devices within prisons.



DETECT & BLOCK

Using the Unify DETECT solution, illegal mobile phone use can be identified and Unify BLOCK utilised to intercept and make the mobile obsolete.



BLOCK & PROTECT

Disturbances within a prison can be managed and contained by using Unify BLOCK at times of unrest amongst prisoners. Prisoners and staff can be protected from such escalations and disturbances by blocking any communication between prisoners, regardless of where they are located. Local communities and victims can be protected from further crimes by blocking any unauthorised contact with the outside world that may constitute illegal activity.

Blocking the use of mobile phones used to coordinate the smuggling of illicit items including drugs, weapons and more mobile phones, protects the integrity of the prison and the safety of staff and prisoners.



BLOCK & CONNECT

Unify CONNECT provides an alternative to the use of illegal mobile phones with in-cell telephones where calls can only be made to pre-approved numbers, and calls are recorded for security purposes.
